Youth in Transition

Program

This program is targeted at youth and young adults who are crown wards and are either living independently or planning to transition into independent living.

In order to participate, youth must be:

- ◇ Aged 16-24
- ◇ Are a crown ward or eligible to receive other Family and Children's Services supports. These include Extended Care and Maintenance, Continued Care and Support for Youth or Renewed Youth Supports.



The Youth In Transition Program provides ongoing support through:

- ◇ Support with (affordable) housing access
- ◇ Assistance with employment and school resources through the Employment and Education Centre
- ◇ Assistance with budgeting and financial planning through 1000 Islands Credit Counselling
- ◇ Connection to community agencies
- ◇ Personal goal development
- ◇ Development of social connections through group and community activities.
- ◇ Peer mentoring and emotional support
- ◇ Personal goals and life skills development
