- 3) **Actions from Previous Meeting Notes**
 - A) **Checkered Flags:** Underway with UCDSB, after Kathy O'Brien's presentation Agencies contacted who may be interested in going to schools on behalf of community agencies to present Checkered Flags as a resource to teachers and staff. This will be happening over the next year, with Kathy O'Brien spearheading. Red Flags training will be piggybacked with this, seen as a seamless approach.
This is not about getting teachers to "diagnose"
Checkered Flags is a document "in transition". Please see Margaret if there are areas missing.
 - B) **Transportation Project:** The hope is that the transportation project will be opened up to all of Leeds and Grenville, hinges on UCLG being interested in helping with funding and agencies showing interest in using the service.
There are a huge number of people who are subsidized for rides and not aware of service, needs to be coordinated.
 - C) **Questions for federal candidates:** Questionnaires were delivered to candidates, answers on website.
- 4) **Update on Letter to Directors of Education**
 - Letter was completed and sent to Director of Education. David Coombs has been asked to follow up for UCDSB. Focus of letter(s) references recognition of involvement from principals and staff in working groups within EKIOC and encourages continued support.
 - Gord Philips added that UCDSB now has a new charter focusing on Mental Health in response to suicides in the region

5) For Decision:

- a) **MCYS:** \$26,000 BSN was reduced by 20% because a desire from gov't to focus on Aboriginal population.
Changes will be made re: Marg's time (leadership). A letter was written and will be sent by co-chairs to underscore concern in reduction of leadership time.
- b) **John McKnight Workshop:** John McKnight speaks on community collaboration, developing community assets.
Beth approached Marg about EKIOC bringing him back in the fall.
Cost would be around \$2000. Lead table would like to move forward with this.

6) Business Reports

MCYS: Youth Dialogues Spring Consultation, across the province and planned for June 11th. MCYS is providing logistical support.

Minister wishes to have a policy statement regarding youth (12-24)

Intent of the event is to bring youth together

Lead Table encouraged to suggest youth who may be interested in this opportunity

Coordinator: Finalized details for workshop on Child and Family centres; will be facilitated by staff from OMSSA already doing this across Ontario, and will provide practical perspectives for planning process phase, and service coordination piece. Both will have *rural* perspectives.

There will be facilitation around community partners thinking about where we are now and where we're going.

Invitations to be sent out by Friday. The workshop will be from 9:30 to 2:30pm, Lead Table encouraged to send staff who don't just work with early years, but pre-natal to age 12. Registration limited to 50-60.

Margaret attended Food Security meeting to give a presentation on our transportation initiative. Margaret would like Carol Chang to present to Lead Table. There was consensus that we should approach her.

Evaluation Grant: Margaret shared EKIOC Logic Model for the project

Dave Huether on **Developmental Assets Meeting:** Looking at how we support the asset building piece going on in various agencies.

Hoping to bring everyone together again in the future (fall?) re: *how* to use the assets

May be approaching some of the schools to have students put together posters based on asset development.

Will be following up with Gord Philips regarding this initiative.
