<p>Work Group Reports: For Information</p> <p>Triple P – Gwendy Lapp</p> <p>A Practitioner Network Meeting was held March 4. 13 practitioners and 1 manager</p>		

attended. The keynote speaker was Joseph Martin of the Six Nations of the Grand River. Joseph is a Triple P practitioner in his community, which has elected to use Triple P because it is evidence based; can withstand the scrutiny of the courts; and has helped reunite families. He explained that Triple P is not modified in his communities, but elders may be brought in to assist. When asked how to best serve FNIM families Joseph responded to provide families with what they are asking for (ie. Parenting instruction, not necessarily other services; they will reach out to those when they are ready). Participants came away with a better understanding of how to offer Triple P to our FNIM families.

The Triple P Data Collection survey is now live and ready for use. We will send out an email reminder for submission of data on a quarterly basis (Apr-June; July-Aug; Sept-Dec; Jan-Mar). The email will be to all Practitioners and the Working Group with a quarterly report being made available to all in return.

Submission of data can be in the following ways:

- monthly, bi-monthly, quarterly
- as an individual practitioner
- as a department/agency for those with an office staff member to collect and enter the data
